Sumner County's RICH MUSIC HERITAGE



Sumner County, Tennessee, located just outside of Nashville, has long been a retreat for country music stars away from Music City. Sumner County residents also helped inspire today's country music genre! Here are ways to connect with Sumner County's country music heritage.



Johnny Cash and June Carter Cash

JC Visit Johnny & June Carter Cash's Homesite

Located at 200 Caudill Drive in Hendersonville was once the home of Johnny and June Carter Cash until their deaths in 2003. In 2007, the home was tragically lost in a house fire. Today, there are three plaques at the site that honor the history of the Cash family on Old Hickory Lake, including a plaque that explains the Cash family and Marty Stuart's connection to "Oh, Pretty Woman" singer and former Sumner County resident, Roy Orbison.

MG Pay Respect to the Legends at Hendersonville Memory Gardens

Johnny Cash, June Carter Cash, Mother Maybelle Carter, Bob Luman, Jean Shepard, and Ferlin Husky are just some of the country music influencers laid to rest at Hendersonville Memory Gardens, located at 353 E Main St., Hendersonville.

CT Drive by Conway Twitty's Former Home

Many guests grew up hearing about Conway Twitty's Twitty City complex located in Hendersonville; today Twitty City is the home to TBN where the variety show *Huckabee* is filmed weekly located at 30 Music Village Blvd., Hendersonville. Drive through the complex to see the *Huckabee* Theater and to see the personalized gate of Conway Twitty that leads to the house (house is not open to the public). Be sure to check out the brick walls when you drive into the complex to see two famous phrases connected to the property!

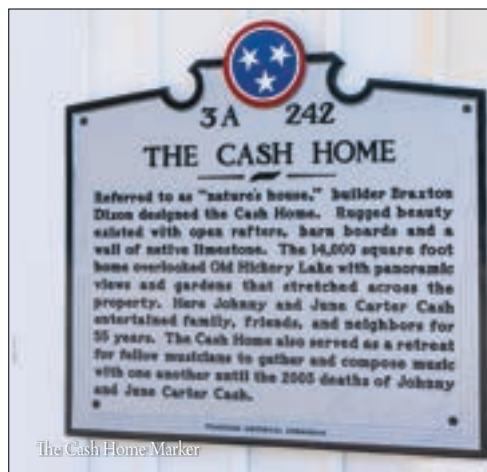
TS Taylor Swift

Taylor's family moved from Pennsylvania to Hendersonville when she was 13 years old so she could be close to Nashville and pursue a career in country music. In 2010, devastating floods hit Middle Tennessee and many areas, including Hendersonville, sustained severe damage. Swift, who attended Hendersonville High School, made a \$100,000 donation to repair the playground in nearby Memorial Park after the flood caused extensive damage. The Taylor Swift Tennessee Music Pathways marker is now located in Memorial Park, near that playground, at 151 E Main St. in Hendersonville.



JC Johnny Cash

Visit Johnny Cash's sign on the Tennessee Music Pathways. Johnny Cash managed his career out of his business that he referred to as the "House of Cash," and the moniker can still be seen above the door! Today a marker highlights the former Cash business, located at 700 E. Main St. (also known as Johnny Cash Parkway), Hendersonville.



The Cash Home Marker

Referred to as "nature's house," builder Braxton Dixon designed the Cash Home. Rugged beauty existed with open rafters, barn boards and a wall of native limestone. The 14,000 square foot home overlooked Old Hickory Lake with panoramic views and gardens that stretched across the property. There Johnny and June Carter Cash entertained family, friends, and neighbors for 35 years. The Cash Home also served as a retreat for fellow musicians to gather and compose music with one another until the 2003 deaths of Johnny and June Carter Cash.



TI The Isaacs

The Isaacs, a family group that began performing in the early 1970s, moved to Hendersonville, Tennessee in 2000. Their music crosses between gospel, bluegrass, country, and Americana, and even though the group has had several lineup changes, Lily Isaacs has remained the core mentor. The band is currently made up of Lily and her three children - Ben, Sonya, and Becky. The Isaacs, already members of the Gospel Music Hall of Fame, were recently inducted into the Grand Ole Opry family. The Isaacs marker is in Veterans Park, 140 Scotch St., Hendersonville.

BA Bill "Hoss" Allen

Bill "Hoss" Allen, born in Gallatin in 1922, was a pioneering rhythm and blues and gospel disc jockey who worked in radio for more than 40 years. His nightly shows on WLAC Nashville played a significant role in broadening the base of R&B and soul music. He helped launch artists like James Brown, Bob Seger, Otis Redding, and Waylon Jennings. In 1994, he was inducted into the Blues Hall



of Fame and in 2010, Allen was inducted into the Gospel Music Hall of Fame. His marker can be found at Bledsoe's Fort Historical Park, 2923 Hartsville Pike, in Castalian Springs.

LF Lefty Frizzel

Lefty Frizzel was a honky-tonk country music artist who spent the last 13 years of his life in Hendersonville, TN. Spending most of his music career in Nashville, he has been recognized by Merle Haggard, Willie Nelson, George Jones, Randy Travis, and other large country stars for his impact on country music. His Tennessee Music Pathway Marker is found at Sanders Ferry



Park, 513 Sanders Ferry Rd., in Hendersonville.

OB Owen Bradley

Owen Bradley was born in Westmoreland, TN in 1915. Bradley played a large role in Nashville's transformation into Music City. He helped shape Nashville into a recording center as a studio owner, producer, session musician, and band leader. He played a pivotal role in the country - pop fusion that became known as the Nashville Sound. Owen Bradley's Tennessee Music Pathway Marker is in Veteran's Memorial Park, 5003 Austin Peay Highway, in Westmoreland.



TS Tennessee Songwriters Week



TN Vacation started Tennessee Songwriters Week to support music venues and songwriters with live performances in all genres of music. Tennessee Songwriters Week is typically in February with hopes to inspire travelers to experience the state's music stories, history, attractions and venues. Tennessee Songwriters Week encourages local songwriters

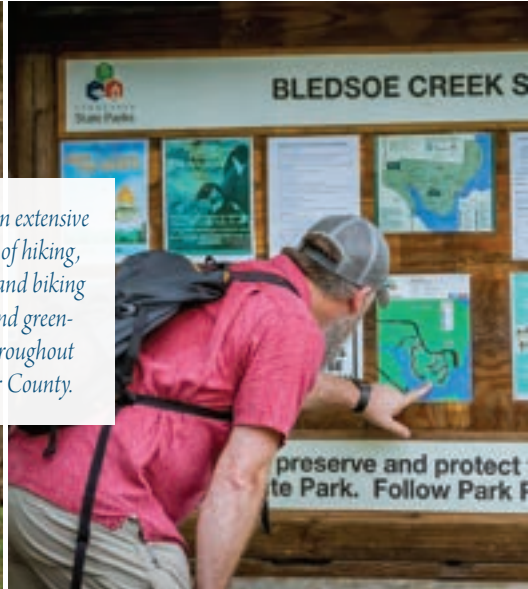
to perform around the state of Tennessee during Qualifying Rounds. Sumner County has hosted several of the qualifying rounds in the last couple of years and was even selected to host a showcase in 2023! The winners from the predetermined showcases get the opportunity to perform at the Bluebird Café in Nashville, TN.



Come and Explore HIKING, BIKING & MORE!



There is an extensive network of hiking, walking and biking trails, and greenways throughout Sumner County.



BC **Bledsoe Creek State Park**
Approximately 6 miles of hiking trails, one mile of which is paved and accessible to persons with a disability. Trails are open year round. (May Wix Trail - 1m; Birdsong Nature Trail - 1m; High Ridge Trail - 3m). 400 Zieglers Fort Rd. | Gallatin | (615) 452-3706

BF **Bledsoe's Fort Historical Park**
The Holston Rd. Hiking Trail passes the historic cemetery and loops around the edge of the park. The Katy Bledsoe Bluebird Trail has a variety of bird houses and leads to remnants of an old springhouse. Several informational markers are along the trail as well as throughout the park. 2923 Hartsville Pike | Castalian Springs (615) 784-9054

MW **Moss-Wright Park**
Moss-Wright Park Loop is a 2.1 mile heavily trafficked loop trail located near Goodlettsville that

features Mansker's Creek and is good for all skill levels. The trail is primarily used for hiking, walking, running, and nature trips and is accessible year-round. 745 Caldwell Dr. | Goodlettsville | (615) 851-2241

HG **Hendersonville Greenways & Bike/Pedestrian Trails**
There are over 6 miles of walking and biking trails located near Indian Lake Boulevard and Saundersville Rd. Saundersville Rd. | Hendersonville | (615) 822-3898

LC **Larkspur Conservation at Taylor Hollow**
Larkspur Conservation Trail is a 2.3 mile lightly trafficked loop trail located near Westmoreland, Tennessee that features beautiful wild flowers and is rated as moderate. The trail is primarily used for hiking, running, and nature trips. Dogs are also able to use this trail but must be kept on leash. 155 Bear Carr Rd. | Westmoreland | (615) 854-0010



L4 Lock-4 Park Mountain Bike Trail

One of the more popular trails in the Nashville area, Lock 4 is approximately 9 miles of well-maintained singletrack. The trail is divided into segments, plus several off-shoots intended for more advanced riders. 1598 Lock 4 Rd. | Gallatin | (615) 451-5911

MP Miracle Park

Miracle Park is 6 acres of A.D.A. compliant recreation for those with mobility impairments, special needs and the community as a whole. The park contains a pedal park, large playground, wheelchair swing, plenty of ramps, poured-in-place ball field surfacing with flat bases and hand railings each equipped with



unique features designed for those physically unable to play at a typical park facility. 240 Champion Dr. | Gallatin | (615) 451-5911

OH Old Hickory Dam Greenway

The Old Hickory Dam Greenway is a short, multi-use trail in the Tailwater Access Area, where the Cumberland River and Old Hickory Lake meet. The trail is mostly wooded, with access to the river from the northern-most parking area. You can access the greenway at Tailwater Access Area on Cinder Rd. or from adjacent Old Hickory Lake Park. RP Richland Park

Richland Park features a hiking & biking trail and a mountain bike trail. The mountain bike loop is a 1.4 mile lightly trafficked loop trail that features beautiful wild flowers and is good for all skill levels. The trail offers a number of activity options and is accessible year-round. 321 Portland Blvd. | Portland | (615) 325-6464

SC Station Camp Greenway

Station Camp Greenway is a 4.1 mile paved greenway that follows Station Camp Creek. The park

is accessible year-round and dogs are permitted but must be kept on leash.

TC Triple Creek Park & Town Creek Greenway

Town Creek Greenway, approximately five miles long, runs along Town Creek, loops under East Broadway, and continues along Town Creek through Gallatin's Historic Woodson Terrace neighborhood into downtown Gallatin.

County Sumner Irish Festival



The County Sumner Irish Festival is a fantastic event held in March at Bledsoe's Fort Historical Park in Castalian Springs, Tennessee. The park is home to an authentic Irish cottage built by Hugh Rogan in the late 1790s, as well as a historic trail that runs alongside a settler cemetery and remnants of a 19th-century spring house. Live Irish music is sure to have you

dancing and toe-tapping! Food and fun create the perfect festive celebration! The event also includes guided hikes, storytelling, craft beer from Half Batch Brewing, historic house tours, kids activities, and food vendors. Wear your favorite Irish-themed attire to participate in the costume contest, pets included, where prizes will be given away!



African American History

There were 27 African American schools in Sumner County. Seven of them were Rosenwald Schools. Parker's Chapel, Rockland, Cotton Town, Kansas, Pilot Knob, Hall's Chapel, Macedonia, Hickory Grove, South Tunnel, Durham's Chapel, Scattersville, South Gallatin, Union High, Village Green, Stark's Knob, Peach Valley, Hart's Hill, Union Elementary, Bledsoe Chapel, St. John, Stewart's, Odom Bend, Cairo, Mt. Olive, Avondale, Oak Grove, and Little Bethel were the schools in which African American children received their education in Sumner County.

Union High School, completed in 1922, was Sumner County's first and only high school for African American students. The first class graduated in 1924, and in 1951, the students moved to the new school due to desegregation of the county's school system. The last senior class graduated in 1970.

Durhams Chapel Rosenwald School is a great example of a two-room Rosenwald school. It was built in 1923 for African Americans during the racial segregation era, and it was used until 1962. The Rosenwald's mission was to be of service to the community, and Durham's Chapel became a community center for African Americans in Bethpage.

The **Cairo Rosenwald School** is in Gallatin, TN. Completed in 1923, it provided education for African American children until 1959. The building is a great example of the standard Rosenwald School design for a one room, one teacher African American school. Closed in 1959 due to the consolidation of schools, this building remains a community center.
