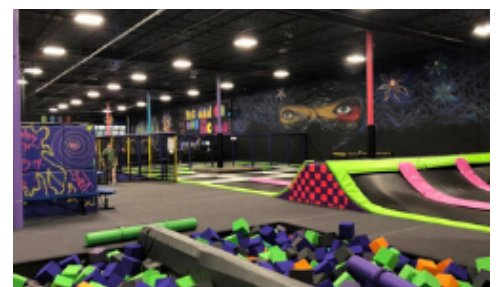


## DINNER AT DEMOS' RESTAURANT
